GUILDERLAND CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT IMMUNIZATION POLICY Updated July 2015

Public Health Law 2164 requires that those children entering School must meet the following vaccine requirements:

- 1. **3-5 doses of DTP or DTaP** (diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis) *Obtaining in age range of 4-6 years is no longer permitted.
- 2. **3-4 doses of IPV/OPV** (polio) *For the 4th dose, obtaining in age range of 4-6 years is no longer permitted.
- 3. **2 doses of MMR vaccine** (measles, mumps, rubella) *For the 2nd dose, obtaining in age range of 4-6 years is no longer permitted.
- 4. 3 doses of Hepatitis B
- 5. **1-2 doses of Varicella** (chicken pox)*
- 6. **1 dose of Tdap** (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) *For students entering sixth grade

A student will not be admitted unless a person in parental relation to the student furnishes the entering school with one of the following:

- 1. A certificate of immunization signed by the administering physician
- 2. A signed statement from the physician stating medical reason for exemption
