# Continuity of Instruction

FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES 9-12



#### **PARTICIPATION**

All students are expected to make every reasonable effort to engage with presented learning opportunities. Understandably, students may have occasional conflicts in their schedule, but these interruptions should be kept to a minimum just like a normal school day.

Individual teachers will provide clear expectations for students.

### SCHEDULE

- Normal schedule of classes
- Class engagements are one hour
- At-home learning is not to exceed three hours per subject, per week, inclusive of the scheduled class times
- Four instructional days (M-TH)
- Science Lab Classes are only 2/4 days
- Friday is to catch up on the week's assignments and to check in with teachers during their office hours



# **CONTENT & RESOURCES**

- A combination of live teaching, recorded lessons, and teacher-designed learning activities
- Teachers will share assignments directly with students
- Condensed curriculum to the most essential concepts
- Special education-related services and ENL instruction will help meet student needs

# COMMUNICATION

It is critical that students make every effort to stay connected with their teachers and to communicate issues as they arise.

- Teachers have office hours every day and will communicate their availability to students, which will provide an opportunity for more individualized support
- Outreach to families whose students are not participating regularly to see if they need assistance

NEL: Has not demonstrated evidence of learning
