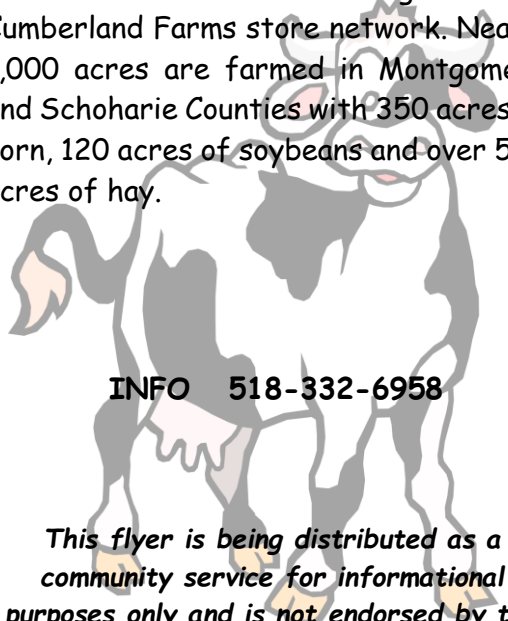




Ridgedale Farm
