


Q1 At which elementary school are you voting today?


Q2 In which town do you live?



Q3 How many years have you been a district resident?





Q4 Are you an employee of the school district?





Q6 If yes, what level(s) of school do they attend?



Q7 If no, did your children ever attend Guilderland Schools?




Q8 If no, will your children attend Guilderland Schools when they are older?


Q9 How old are you?



Q11 Why did you vote YES on the proposed 2022-23 budget? (Check all that apply.)






Q13 Of the following communication channels, what were your three best sources of information about the proposed budget? (Please check three only.)


