Rollover Budget

- Assumes all staffing and programs remain constant
- Project revenue and expenses using <u>known</u> <u>data</u> or that which can be <u>reasonably</u> <u>anticipated</u> given information available at the time
- Trending of historical data or information from outside organizations provides a basis for determining estimates
