Summer's Story

Summer Leigh Smith was a loving mother of three young boys who lost her 12 year battle with addiction on January 9, 2015. As a young child, who was raised in Guilderland, New York, Summer was a victim of childhood sexual abuse. This abuse later lead to her use of drugs and alcohol to cover the pain and shame she felt. She once told her mother, "I was an addict before I even knew I was".

Summer had just completed a positive year in recovery when on January 9,2015 she suffered a relapse her body could not sustain. Although the path was difficult, she never gave up on her desire to have a life lived in recovery. We believe it would be Summer's wish for her story to be told, knowing that it could have a positive impact on another person's life.

Summer was never shy about her addiction, and we wish to follow in her footsteps. We have established this race in Summer's honor to help stop the stigma surrounding addiction and help support those in recovery while providing education and prevention services to those who have not yet chosen this path.
