
## **Summer's Story**



Summer Leigh Smith was born on a beautiful summer day in San Diego, California on June 11th, 1983. Reflecting the season in which she was born, she was a bright and warm child. She attended Lynwood Elementary School and Farnsworth Middle School in Guilderland. Tragically, she was a victim of child sexual abuse at a very young age. As so many victims of childhood trauma do, she sought to cover the confusion, shame and pain that she felt with the use of drugs and alcohol. While a student at Guilderland High School she experimented with various drugs and alcohol. Graduating high school, she soon became a mother. Trying to be the best parent she could be at such a young age was difficult, and addiction soon took over, resulting in a battle that she would fight over the next 12 years. During these years, she became a mother of two more boys and fought hard to become the mother they deserved.

Summer's fight was not an easy one, yet it was typical of one battling the disease of addiction. Many years of therapy, rehabilitation and several diagnoses of mental health issues related to her early childhood sexual abuse led her to the door step of

Schenectady Drug Court where she began the rigorous program that would lead her through one of the best years of her life. Reunited with family, amends made, an active and loving mother of her three boys, Summer was in a wonderful place. She was a resident of the Schenectady YWCA Women's Housing Pro- gram and had just completed a 5 K race led by mentors of the STEM (Strong Through Every Mile) Program. Crossing the finish line in December 2014 was a moment of empowerment for Summer and the many women she ran with. After a Christmas spent with family, she settled into the New Year with hopes and aspirations for 2015. Tragically on January 9th, 2015 Summer succumbed to the disease of addiction, with a relapse that her body could not sustain. Summer never wanted to be an "addict", she only wanted to be loved and to be a good mother. As she told her mother, "I wish I had never ever picked up that first drug. I became an addict before I ever knew I was". Today



Summer is survived by three amazing sons, currently ages 22, 14 and 13. In her memory, Summer's Mom, Kristin Smith established this race to raise awareness of the disease of addiction, reduce the associated stigma and to support a culture that that celebrates lives lived in recovery.
